Questions and Answers about the 2022 Environmental Compliance Consultant for Klamath Basin Conservation Grantmaking Programs Request for Qualifications

February 16, 2022

NFWF accepted questions about the RFP in writing through February 14, 2022. All questions and answers have been posted on NFWF's [website](#) so that all offerors have access to them at the same time. Similar questions have been combined.

1. What is the duration of the contract?

The contract duration will be for one year with the opportunity to renew for up to four years.

2. Will the consultant(s) be directly added to a roster after this submittal, if selected? Or will the selected consultant(s) have additional RFQs/RFPs to respond to down the line?

If NFWF is satisfied with the selected contractor after Year 1, the recipient will not have to respond to additional RFQs/RFPs in the future. The renewals will occur via amendments.

3. Do you have an idea of the number of projects that will be completed per year (so that we can make sure we include adequate staff)?

We anticipate awarding 15–20 projects in the first year of funding and 10–15 in subsequent years.

4. Will the contract be awarded to separate contractors for each basin or one contractor for both?

To be determined based on interest and responses.

5. Is it permissible to have another contractor on our team, such as a cultural contractor that would cover the NHPA work specifically?
