

Bats for the Future Fund 2024 Request for Proposals

Applicant Webinar: TODAY

Proposals Due: Thursday, September 19th

Review and Notification: October - November

Awards Announced: January 2025

Grant Agreement Issued: within 3 months (typical)

Grant Implementation: No more than 3 years. Projects that achieve

proposed outcomes within two years are preferred.

Awards: \$50k to \$250k each*

Match: 50% of request is encouraged but not required

*If a higher amount is requested, contact NFWF staff in advance for guidance










2024 Bats for the Future Fund Objectives

- Prevent exposure and/or enhance ability to withstand WNS
- Help bat populations recover
- Support innovative and collaborative research leading directly to the deployment of treatments, tools or strategies

Program Priorities: Overarching

- Implement strategies that will have a meaningful impact on survival of bat populations
- Adaptive implementation of conventional and/or experimental management actions with a sound study design
- The most competitive proposals will aim to implement treatments and management solutions to minimize the short and long-term impacts of the disease and encourage recovery in persisting populations
- Cross-disciplinary approaches and collaborations are encouraged

Program Priorities: Two Categories

- Deliver treatments or implement management tools and strategies that prevent exposure of bats to infectious Pd or improve survival from WNS. Sound study design to monitor/evaluate results
- Deliver treatments or implement management tools or habitat conservation strategies in the field that help WNS-affected bat populations to recover from the impacts of WNS. Research needs to show path to implementation

Community Impact and Engagement

Projects should engage community-level partners (e.g., municipalities, NGOs, community organizations, community leaders) to help design, implement, and maintain projects to secure maximum benefits for communities, maintenance, and sustainability post-grant award.

Ineligible Use of Funds & Equipment Guidance

Funds/Match may *not* be used to support:

- X Species composition, distribution, movement and habitat-use studies
- X Unrelated monitoring studies
- X Development of WNS detection methods or tools, UNLESS the development is directly related to deployment of a treatment method
- X Outreach and education programs
- X Political advocacy, lobbying, etc.

Refer to the RFP for the full list of ineligible uses of BFF grant funds

Equipment: rent equipment where possible and cost-effective **or** use matching funds for purchase

Permits and Approvals Regulatory Compliance

Proposals must show planning for, knowledge about and secure compliance with federal, state and local law and regulation

!!Start pre-consultations with relevant agencies as soon as possible!!

Awarded projects often experience delays due to federal compliance requirements being incomplete. If your project is awarded, your federal compliance requirements should be completed as soon as possible to avoid project timeline delays and delays in receiving payment.

Regulatory Compliance (cont.)

TIPS

- Secure landowner permission and document this (via email or letter)
- Plan and budget time and resources needed to obtain necessary approvals in BFF workplan and budget
- Make sure the "Permits" section of online application is complete
- Review article <u>A Decision Support Tool for Determining Federal Regulatory</u> <u>Authority over Products for Vertebrate Animals</u> (link in RFP)
- Consider and address state and local regulations

Regulatory Compliance (cont.)

- Refer to NEPA, ESA, and NHPA templates found at www.nfwf.org/bats
 - See 'Application Information' Tab on BFF Page
 - <u>SEE FIRST</u> Environmental Compliance Checklist for NFWF Projects
 - FWS Environmental Compliance Template
 - NEPA CATEX (Categorical Exclusion) Form Fillable
 - For ESA review help, visit the USFWS <u>iPaC website</u> and follow the instructions to generate a list of species and any critical habitat areas. This can then be provided to NFWF for review.
- An overall guide to NEPA can be found on the <u>NEPA.gov website</u>.
- Recipients must complete the required forms and provide them to NFWF for review. The NFWF team will then elevate them to USFWS for review.
- NEPA is a responsibility of the subrecipient and should be done at the local level. If you are experiencing any challenges, please reach out to the NFWF team.










Easygrants Full Proposal Main Page






